Our office has soil probes available to check out.Be sure to gather enough soil for an adequate sample. Make sure the soil is dry. Our office sends soil Monday through Wednesday to the lab for testing. Typically, this time of year results can take up to two weeks to return.

How much does a soil test cost?

\$7.42 each

How often should I test?

It is recommended to test fields every three to four years.




